We aim at involving 2 business schools and 20 health tech companies to create an entrepreneurship education program in health innovation with the goal to generate 10 marketable health tech solutions and 5 new startups/spinoffs.

Description

European strategy actions for universities

- Incubators within higher education institutions in close cooperation with the entrepreneurial sector, to help student entrepreneurs to develop their ideas into businesses
- Innovative teaching and learning such as living labs
- Future-proof skills development and entrepreneurship/ innovation competences in higher education
- Co-design of curricula between private sector innovators and higher education institutions
- Strengthening and sharing of technology transfer capacities for example through spin-offs
